HOW WE HELP—LOSING VISION DOESN'T MEAN LOSING INDEPENDENCE!

COUNSELING*

- Adjustment to vision changes, education and support
- Information about area resources and support groups

SAFE MOVEMENT AND TRAVEL*

- Training in white cane use, sighted guide technique and safe travel skills
- Orientation to neighborhoods

INDEPENDENT LIVING*

- Training in a variety of practical skills that enable people to continue with many daily activities
- In home assessment and training for adaptive living and communication skills

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES

- Information and demonstrations on hardware, software and other AT resources
- Personalized one on one tutorials

LOW VISION CLINIC

- Functional vision evaluation by an Optometric Physician
- Specialized training in the use of low vision devices
